1. Coordinator's Report
 - a. December 12, 2012 Minutes – Steve reviewed the minutes. They were approved as written.
 - b. CCSTEM Budget and Actuals Report dated 1/14/2013 with total expenditures of \$45, 626 was distributed by Steve. – We will need to take a closer look over the next couple of months to make sure we spend our funding and may need to ask for a minor time extension.
 - c. Mini-grant Status Report (\$7,500, list included in agenda) – All mini-grants from the first round have been funded. Others since are in process, pending receipt of contracts.
 - d. New website hosting – Our new host cost is \$10 per month.
 - e. CSLNet grant – It ends in March, and we will need to write the final report by March 31st.
2. Meeting Dates and Venues – Anne Marie volunteered to arrange for the locations of the general meetings, the next one in February and future ones. We will try to schedule these for Mondays. See below the Proposed Upcoming Meetings and Events list for 2013.
3. Pub Science Update – Dawn Hinchman reported Dr. Raul Cano, who makes fossil fuel beer, said that he is available the first week in March. Creekside Brewing is a possible location for this event. There was some conversation about how to name this event; we agreed to name this event “Science After Dark”.
4. CSLNet Regional Meeting – Every 3 months, there is a regional meeting of the now 9 region member organizations. John attended the December 2012 meeting and received CSLNet Regional Networks Participation and Reporting Guidelines, a draft Letter of Agreement Regarding the CSLNet Regional Network STEM Partnership, and forms for CSLNet Site Visits. The next regional meeting will be held May 24-25; location TBD. The US STEM Summit, sponsored by US News and World Report, will be held June 17-19, in Austin, Texas. The California STEM Summit is on November 18-19 in Sacramento (which John, Steve, Jane and Lilly will attend).
5. What's the focus? - Our CSLNet grant runs out on March 31st. We need a plan from now until March 31st, and then another plan for the rest of the year after March 31st.

With Delia facilitating, we agreed upon the following criteria for selecting our focus:

 - a) Be seen as an active organization
 - b) Develop a track record
 - c) Use free or easy/existing resources (fund-able)
 - d) Level of visibility – outcomes for kids and community
 - e) What community and businesses like and need

- f) Connected to uniqueness about Central Coast
- g) Connect with North and South larger events
- h) “Sexy” grant opportunities

We then compiled a list of focus ideas that appealed to most of the members, reviewed and added ideas, then agreed on the following focus areas:
