Common Core State Standards and Next Generation Science Standards

Central Coast public schools are actively in the process of beginning the implementation of <u>Common</u> <u>Core State Standards (CCSS)</u>. This is going to be a very challenging, frustrating and lengthy process taking at least several years or more. Many teachers are feeling the pressure. This will become a serious concern for caring parents. CCSTEM is working to support CCSS roll-out, especially assisting however we can in teacher training, parent education and public outreach.
