### Successful October 12th CCSTEM Forum at UCSB

The second annual CCSTEM Education Forum, "*Building Bridges in STEM*", was held at UCSB's Corwin Pavilion, on Friday, October 12th, from 9 AM to about 3 PM, hosted by UCSB's Gevirtz Graduate

School of Education. Event facilitator's were Gevirtz School Dean **Jane Conoley**, and **John Keller**, Director of Cal Poly SLO's Center for Excellence in Science and Mathematics Education.

There were about 150 people in attendance from Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo Counties. In the morning were presentations and a panel discussion on STEM education parternships with non-profit organizations and businesses. Following a boxed-sandwich lunch, the afternoon was filled with "STEM Landscapes" outside in the gorgeous weather, in which local non-profit STEM education and support organizations, businesses and STEM student teams from local K-12 schools and UCSB exhibited and demonstrated their operations, classwork and projects.
