The webinar will discuss innovative Induction approaches for new teachers—including those affected by layoffs—to complete their credential and address Transitional K-Grade 12 priorities, such as the CCSS and NGSS.

The webinar will focus on advances in performance-based assessment of teacher candidates and outcome measures for evaluating teacher education programs. It will also lay a foundation for next steps in California Alliance local partnerships.
