2. In the request, include the following:
 - a. Organization Name
 - b. Organization Type
 - c. Presentation Date, Time and Location
 - d. Audience Size
 - e. Speakers Needed (type of presentation you are seeking/discussion topic)
 - f. Contact Information

Please include any additional notes about the presentation you are requesting and any particular requirements you have.

Once you submit your request, you will receive a response confirming the details from the request. As soon as we have a speaker secured for the presentation, you will be notified immediately.
